In Orvieto, we will see the most beautiful façade in Italy at the cathedral and venerate the Eucharistic miracle that inspired the hymns of St. Thomas Aquinas and initiated the Feast of Corpus Christi.

I am pleased to be joined by Father Joseph de Orbegozo, PhL, rector of the Cathedral of St. Andrew in Little Rock. In addition to enjoying the pilgrimage with us, he will be offering Mass and homily for us throughout our pilgrimage and blessing us with his insights and prayer.



Daily Itinerary

✚ April 21, Monday, DAY 1: DEPART FROM USA

After celebrating Easter at home, we depart on our flights to Rome. Dinner and breakfast are served on the flight. Quotes for add-on domestic flights and optional Premium Economy or Business Class upgrades are available upon request.

✚ April 22, Tuesday, DAY 2: ARRIVAL IN ITALY

We arrive at Rome airport this morning, where our English-speaking Italian tour manager will meet us and help us board the bus which takes us to eternal Rome, bathed in its unique golden light with cypress and pine trees outlined against the blue sky. We arrive at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls for a visit and to celebrate Mass. Upon entering the welcoming courtyard, we are greeted by the famous statue of St. Paul holding the Scriptures and a sword. Passing through our first Holy Door of the Jubilee, we ponder the frescoes of Paul's life and the medallions of all the Popes from Peter to Francis. Under the main altar, we venerate the tomb of St. Paul. Nearby, we visit the Tre Fontane Convent to see where St. Paul was beheaded. In the afternoon, settle into our hotel to relax before dinner. Overnight in Rome. (D)

✚ April 23, Wednesday, DAY 3: AUDIENCE WITH THE POPE – TOUR OF THE SCAVI – BASILICA OF ST. MARY MAJOR - ST. PRAXEDES

We begin early to get good seats at St. Peter's Square for the General Audience with the Holy Father. We then enjoy a tour of the Scavi, the underground burial tombs below the Basilica, leading to the tomb of St. Peter (TBC). Following the traditional Italian pranzo (lunch) in a local restaurant, we drive to St. Mary Major Basilica, pass through the Holy Door, and celebrate Mass. Built immediately after the Council of Ephesus (431), which declared the Virgin Mary to be the Theotokos, the Bearer of God, the Basilica is the principal church dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, with relics of the Bethlehem crib. We then visit the early Christian "house church," St. Praxedes, which contains relics of thousands of early Christian martyrs, and the remarkable mosaic Chapel of St. Xenobios. The rest of the afternoon and evening are yours to explore at your own pace or enjoy Rome's shopping streets. Dinner tonight is at leisure. Overnight in Rome. (B.L)

✚ April 24, Thursday, DAY 4: VATICAN GARDENS – VATICAN MUSEUMS – ST. PETER'S BASILICA – CATACOMBS OF ST. CALIXTUS

We start the day with a tour of the Vatican Gardens. Next, we tour the Vatican Museum where we see the works of Giotto, DaVinci, Raphael, Michelangelo, Bernini, Titian, Caravaggio and others. Discover the beautiful Raphael Stanzas, which lead to the Sistine Chapel, where the popes are elected. Here the cardinals in the conclave contemplate the history of salvation, culminating in the Last Judgment by Michelangelo. We pass through the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica and explore the church's history, art, theology, and architecture. We pray at the tombs of dozens of popes and saints, marveling at the expanse of the church, Michelangelo's Pieta, Bernini's Baldachino, and Michaelangelo's magnificent dome. You may wish to climb the many flights of stairs to the cupola dome of St. Peter's or shop for religious articles in the many shops around St. Peter's Square. Following lunch together, we travel to the ancient Appian Way to visit the Catacombs, where the early Christians prayed in secret. We visit the Catacombs of St. Callixtus, featuring the tombs of early popes, early frescoes, St. Cecilia's original burial place, and the site of Pope Sixtus II's martyrdom in 258 AD. We celebrate Mass at the Catacombs. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B.L.D)

✚ April 25, Friday, DAY 5: CITY OF CHURCHES, SAINTS, ART, AND FOUNTAINS

Our walking tour through Rome's historic center includes Chiesa Nuova with its tomb of St. Philip Neri; the beautiful fountains of Piazza Navona; Church of St. Agnes where St. Agnes was martyred and the relic of her head resides; Church of Sant'agostino with the tomb of St. Monica; Church of St. Luigi, with its famous paintings by Caravaggio including the favorite of Pope Francis, the Call of St. Matthew. After lunch on our own, we visit the Church of the Twelve Apostles with the tombs of the Apostles Philip and James the Less; the Church of the Gesu with the tomb of St. Ignatius of Loyola and the hand of St. Francis Xavier; and Santa Maria Sopra Minerva with the tomb of St. Catherine of Siena and Blessed Fra Angelico, the patron of artists. We also visit the amazing Pantheon and the memorable Trevi Fountain. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B.D)

✠ April 26, Saturday, DAY 6: COLISSEUM – ARCHBASILICA OF ST. JOHN LATERAN – BASILICA OF SANTA CROCE

We visit the Colisseum and have a view of the ancient Roman Forum (TBC). We tour the Basilica of Santa Croce which houses relics of Christ's Passion and was built over soil from the Holy Land brought by St. Helen. Walk to the nearby Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, the cathedral of Rome and the mother church of the world, where the popes resided from the time of Constantine until the papacy moved to Avignon and then to St. Peter's in 1377. We pass through the Holy Door and marvel at the colossal marble statues of the apostles. Above the altar are reliquaries containing the heads of Sts. Peter and Paul. In the baptistry, converts were baptized by the pope in the early centuries. We then visit the Scala Sancta (The Holy Stairs) from Jerusalem, the blood-stained staircase where Jesus was presented to Pilate. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B.D)

April 27, Sunday, DAY 7: SHRINE OF DIVINE MERCY – ASSISI – BASILICA OF SANTA MARIA DEGLI ANGELI

We begin Divine Mercy Sunday by celebrating Mass in Italian at the Santo Spirito Church, Rome's Shrine of Divine Mercy, and venerate relics of Saints Faustina and John Paul II. We then depart Rome and travel to Assisi, a medieval town perched on the slopes of Mount Subasio, the jewel of Umbria, the "Green Heart of Italy." The town is one of Italy's spiritual treasures and the home of the beloved Sts. Francis and Clare. Our first visit is to the Basilica of Santa Maria Degli Angeli (St. Mary of the Angels). This baroque basilica contains the Portiuncula, the heart of Franciscan spirituality, the chapel built by St. Francis for his community, and the place where he died. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B.D)

✠ April 28, Monday, DAY 8: BASILICA OF ST. FRANCIS – BASILICA OF ST. CLARE – TOMB OF BL. CARLO ACUTIS – CHURCH OF SAN DAMIANO

We start the day with a visit to the Church of San Damiano, just outside Assisi, the church where Jesus told St. Francis, "Rebuild my church." It was the first monastery of the Order of Saint Clare, where Saint Clare built her community and where she died. Our next stop is the Basilica of St. Clare. Here we pray at the original cross that spoke to St. Francis, see the preserved body of St. Clare, and venerate the relics of the saints. We then pray at Assisi's Sanctuary of the Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major, where the young St. Francis cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Here we venerate the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, who died in 2006 at the age of 15, the first millennial to be beatified by the Catholic Church. He had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and an aptitude for website design. His holy body is dressed in jeans and tennis shoes. Next we proceed to the Basilica of St. Francis, where we celebrate Mass. We pray at the tomb of St. Francis and further explore the Upper Church and the Lower Church with our expert guide. Following lunch, enjoy time to explore Assisi on your own and do some last-minute shopping. Spend the rest of the day at leisure in this holy place before returning for dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B.D)

✠ April 29, Tuesday, DAY 9: MIRACLE OF BOLSENA – ORVIETO – CATTEDRALE DI SANTA MARIA ASSUNTA – WINE AND CHEESE TASTING – FAREWELL DINNER

After breakfast, we drive to the remarkable hilltop village of Orvieto, the place of refuge for five popes in the 13th century. When the miraculous Corporal was processed from Bolsena to Orvieto, Pope Urban IV met the procession at the cathedral and enshrined the blood-stained corporal in a golden reliquary where it is kept today in the Chapel of the Corporal. Pope Urban, deeply affected by this miracle, commissioned St. Thomas Aquinas to compose a Mass and Office honoring the Holy Eucharist. The hymns that St. Thomas wrote included the Pange Lingua, with its concluding verses, the Tantum Ergo, the Panis Angelicus, and O Salutaris Hostia. One year after the miracle, the pope introduced Aquinas' composition and instituted the Feast of Corpus Christi. The facade of the Orvieto Duomo, the Cattedrale di Santa Maria Assunta, is one of the most beautiful in all of Italy. We enjoy a tour of the exterior and interior of this remarkable church and celebrate Mass. Orvieto is also known for its prestigious white and red wines, produced in the area's rolling vineyards. Learn about the history and production of local vintages at a wine and cheese tasting with five wines of the region. After exploring the scenic village, we enjoy our final meal together in a local restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in the Frascati wine region. (B. Lunch and wine tasting. Special dinner)

✠ April 30, Wednesday, DAY 10: RETURN HOME

After breakfast, we transfer from our hotel to the Rome airport and return home with memories to savor for a lifetime. (B)
